

# Quorndon Parish Council

## Environment Committee – April 2008

The Environment Committee shall be a Standing Committee appointed under the Council's Standing Orders for committees.

### **Committee Composition**

1. The Environment Committee shall consist of a Chairman and up to 5 other Council members, appointed by Council at its Annual Meeting. Other members wishing to raise or comment on particular issues may attend by invitation. A minimum of 4 meetings to be held annually.

### **Committee Remit**

1. Monitor, review and make recommendations to Council on matters relating to traffic and road safety.
2. Monitor, review and make recommendations to Council on tidiness in the village, including litter, graffiti, dog-fouling and street cleaning
3. Plan, design, obtain permits for, and implement local greening projects including beds, containers, planters, baskets, established green areas and improvements to derelict/untidy locations.
4. Manage the routine upkeep of all public spaces including grass cutting, maintenance, public seating and repair work.
5. Plan and monitor capital projects involving public spaces.

### **Delegated Powers**

1. Authorise expenditure within the **Recreation Areas** annual budget under the headings, and within the limits of, the amounts approved by Council.
