



QPC October 2017 - Briefing Note 7 - Quorn Neighbourhood Plan Advisory Committee

1. Theme Groups Meetings:

The four theme groups have Housing and Built Environment, Environment and Green Spaces (Natural and Historic Environment), Community Facilities and Traffic and Transport are all underway and have had at least one meeting. The feedback so far from the groups and Yourlocale has been good.

2. Funding:

The Locality grant has now been spent. A Yourlocale invoice to cover theme group initial work (including preparation and follow-up) has been received for £1,560. This will be paid from the 'Awards for All' grant (£9,750). Funds remaining = **£8,190**

3. Consultation Survey (Questionnaire):

these available for residents to complete between **6th to the 30th November**. A 'Flyer' is being distributed to residents by volunteers. There are two 'on line' links, one for the Young People and one for the Adults surveys. Paper copies are available for those that can't access the web. The preferred option is 'on line' however, 200 paper copies of each are available for those that cannot access the web. These are available from the Parish Office and the Library who have kindly offered the 'free to use' public computers. Press releases and social media notifications have been issued. It is also planned to promote the questionnaires on the street during the month.
