QPC July 2018 - Briefing Note 16

1. **QPC Special Meeting:** took place on Monday 16 July 2018 and the Council unanimously approved the Draft pre-submission plan. Several landowners and their agents attended as members of the public. This approval means that the Plan can now move to the Regulation 14 Consultation stage which will run from 23 July until 7 September 2018. The Minutes of Meeting are available on the council web site.
2. **Draft Report:** a copy had been sent to all members and it and all the supporting documentation is available to view in the Parish Office, the Community Library and on the Leicestershire Communities web site at:

3. **Notifications:** all Mandatory Stakeholders and others have been notified individually and the statutory notifications have been placed on the Parish Notice Boards. In addition, articles were sent to the Loughborough Echo and the Quorn News. The Village News and Diary pages of the Quondon website, Nextdoor and the NP Facebook page all contain the information. Thank you to the Clerk for achieving this in time for the consultation period to commence on 23 July. We have decided that the consultation period will run for seven weeks until 7 September this is to ensure that minimum period of 6 six weeks is covered. The original VDS participants have also been informed.
4. **Implementation Plan:** The NP progress is continuing, a lot has been achieved in a short time but there is still some way to go:
 1. Regulation 14 period commences - **23 JULY**
 2. Regulation 14 period terminates – **7 SEPTEMBER**
 3. Amendments agreed, and Submission Version of NP signed off by NPAC/QPC – Target - **Early OCTOBER**
5. **Funding:**
Groundwork UK Locality grant funding: Locality grant Ref: NPG-10104 request for £4700 was submitted on 23 April and was agreed by letter dated 20 May.

The National Lottery Awards for All Grant: Project ID: 0010310366 for £9750 a request for an extension of the spend by date of 21 July has been extended until 31 October.
