QPC November 2018 - Briefing Note 19

1. The Submission Version of the Councils Plan was approved by Council on 2 October 2018.
2. The Councils Plan Submission Version and the associated Regulation 15 documentation were received by the Borough Council on 8 October.
3. The Borough Council did a great job checking the submitted documents in such a short time and then informed us that the submission met all the necessary regulations.
4. The pre-examination consultation commenced on Monday 15th October and ran until Monday 26th November 2018.
5. CBC proposed Andrew Ashcroft, a member of the Neighbourhood Planning Independent Examiner Referral Service (NPIERS) to be the independent Examiner. Andrew has extensive experience as an Examiner and following the support of Yourlocale he was accepted. Andrews initial comments are very encouraging and reflect well on all of those involved.
I would be delighted to examine the Plan if selected to do so by Charnwood District Council and the Parish Council. I have looked at the submitted Plan and its associated documentation. It is clear that the wider package has been prepared and presented in a very effective manner. The range of policies in the Plan (and their applicability to the neighbourhood area) is very impressive. The Plan is a distinctive document and provides a clear vision for the neighbourhood area.
6. An informal meeting of interested parties took place on Wednesday on 21/11 to explore avenues to take the NP Community Actions forward.
