Stafford Orchard Park Management Committee

The Park Management Committee shall be a Committee appointed under the Council's Standing Orders for committees.

Committee Composition

1. The Park Management Committee shall consist of, but not be limited to, a Chairman (elected by its members), the Park Manager (parish clerk), the Groundsman, two members of council (appointed by Council at its Annual meeting), the chief Park Warden, and two community volunteers.
2. Non-Councillors may not vote on financial matters.

Committee Remit

1. Manage Stafford Orchard park (including the entrance plaza) for the benefit of the community.
2. Maintain the park to high standards including those agreed with, and approved by, the National Lottery Heritage Fund
3. Establish and manage policies governing use of the park
4. Produce plans for, and manage the implementation of, new facilities in the park
5. Monitor and further develop the park audience
6. Promote and market the park for public events, galas, concerts, drama, exhibitions, shows etc
7. Apply annually for a Green Flag Award

Delegated Powers

1. Advise the Park Manager on expenditure from the **Park Management Committee** annual **Revenue** budget. The Park Manager (clerk) may authorise such expenditure under the headings, and within the limits, of the budgets approved by Council.
2. Advise the Park Manager on capital expenditure from the **Stafford Orchard Capital Account**. The Park Manager may authorise expenditure from the **Account** not exceeding the limit held in the account.
3. Provide funding for events in the park within the budget approved by Council for this purpose.
